Meanwhile, discussions surrounding the integration of equity, diversity, and inclusion emphasized breaking down systemic barriers



and promoting inclusivity. Through a review of governance structure, attendees identified areas of improvement, emphasizing the importance of unified membership criteria across all levels. The symposium explored plenty of topics surrounding development and education, advocating for year-round access to exams and improved instructor training. The transition to a commission model was further discussed, with great insights from successful provincial implementations. When looking ahead to the future, the importance of consistent communication and effective governance were emphasized. The symposium reinforced a commitment to building a more inclusive, transparent, and supportive environment for all officials.
