-QUESTIONS PAR LES MEMBRES -

Question 1:

MMBRA Executive Decision / discussion:

This has been on the MMBRA Board of Directors agenda and has been tabled to allow the season to start. The MMBRA board will discuss this during this season as making a decision like this at this time, we do not want to be rushed and require further discussion.



Question 2:

Will the MMBRA membership be notified of these new officials we will be working with? Will there be a published list of Associate Members, so we are informed of these new officials?

Will Associate Members be required to identify themselves as just Associate Members?

Will Associate Members be bound to our Code of Ethics as well?

Will the MMBRA membership be encouraged and supported if we report violations of code of Ethics by Associate Members.

MMBRA Executive Decision / discussion:

A list of Associate members will be managed by the MMBRA Secretary with input from the Supervision Committee and Discipline Committee. Each Assignor will also be notified.

Each Associate member must sign an agreement that they agree to follow the rules of MMBRA as well as be responsible to their own board. An Associate member must also sign the MMBRA Code of Conduct and is subject to all fines and discipline as a regular member.

Question 3:

If referees will need to pay to be supervised/evaluated, many will not request this especially for younger/newer referees. This might and will restrict the development of our referees and our associations as a whole. Supervision should be covered by MMBRA or at least keeping the fee a simple 10-20\$.

If not, increased supervision during tournaments might be an alternative.

MMBRA Executive Decision / discussion:

A rookie official pays for their supervision through their fee pay to take the course. Under the new NOCP program offered by Basketball Canada the process requires officials to pay to be evaluated. As members prepare to go through the process, being able to ask for supervision will help in the NOCP process. The decision to charge for supervision is part of the process to moving forward and is a common practice in other sports.

Seules les lois et annexes approuvées à la majorité votée seront ajoutées au document final. Les lois ou annexes non définies seront examinées et soumises pour un nouveau vote.

Le système de vote est contrôlé, et votre nom ne sera révélé à aucun conseil d'administration, comité ou membre de la MMBRA.

On vous demandera d'entrer votre nom de famille puisque chaque membre dispose d'un vote. Cette information ne servira qu'à certifier le vote. Seuls les membres en règle peuvent voter.

You will be asked to vote Yes or No on the eight (8) proposed by-laws and the thirteen (13) appendixes. When you vote on either a by-law or appendix, you are voting on every article in that by-law or appendix.

If you wish not to vote on a by-law or appendix, you can choose to abstain.

A by-law or appendix will only pass if the majority of votes are yes.

Example if we have 100 total votes

65 Yes

20 No

15 Abstain

Yes, has the most votes and is approved.

Only voted majority approved by-laws and appendixes will be added to the final document. Non-finalized by laws or appendixes will be reviewed and submitted for another vote.

The voting system is controlled, and your name will not be revealed to any member of the MMBRA Board or Committee.

You will be asked to enter your family name as each member has one vote. This information will only be used to certify the vote. Only members in good standing can vote.

Voting will Start October 1st and end on October 7th at 5:00pm.
